It is a lovely time to visit Kew; it is quieter and cooler, but just as interesting and vibrant. The weather is usually still warm enough and Kew comes into its own in autumn when many of the hundreds of tree species are at their most colourful. Kew Palace, located within the gardens, is well worth a visit and is free entry. The smallest of the Royal Palaces, it offers a fascinating view of the intimate personal and domestic lives of Georgian kings and queens for much of the 18th century. Perhaps venture into the high-altitude territory of Davies Alpine House and experience the cool, dry and windy conditions that allow alpine plants to flourish.
